This book is written on more than 800 pages and covers all aspects in the field of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation in 11 chapters. It is written in outline form, and the topics are divided into major subspecialty areas, and are authored by physicians with special interests and clinical expertise in respective subjects. It is a very good review for residents preparing for Board or Fellowship, or even for physicians preparing for recertification in the field of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation. This book is not a substitute for a textbook, and the author assumes that the readers will have studied at

It also contains many diagrams, and tables, which clarify the topics related.
