Saudi Medical Journal is retracting this article after concluding that it has been extensively plagiarized (over 90%) from a previous study by Yip S, Fung H, Fung T, "Emergency cervical cerclage: A study between duration of cerclage in situ with gestation at cerclage, hemiation of forewater, and cervical dilatation at presentation", European Journal of Obstetrics, Gynecology, and Reproductive Biology 1998; 78: 63-67.
